PROGRAM OUTCOMES & ACHEIVMENTS SUMMARY

Court Child Care

- * CCC served 345 families & 941 children
- * 72% of caretakers said they would have had no other childcare available if not for CCC

Elementary Second Step

- * 963 students participated in the program
- * 100% of teachers believe the program is effective
- * The overall social-emotional score increased at each school site

Adolescent Parenting Program

- *14 teen parents received the Parents As Teachers curriculum
- *100% showed improvement on the Life Skills Progression scale, measuring their overall well--being
- *100% report they learned skills they will use in their daily life

Early Learning Second Step

- *792 children received weekly social emotional lessons
- *1011 lessons were delivered
- *83% of sites improved their Protective Factors score with 86% of children scoring in the strength or typical range

Strengthening Families Program

- 36 youth completed the SF 14-week program
- 100% of parents reported a positive change in their child
- 100% of youth reported an improved relationship with their parent

Supervised Visitation & Exchange

- *123 families & 174 children received over 963 hours of supervised visits
- *91% of families can with a court order
- *36% of children witnessed home violence
